

According to Adobe's Theon Weber, Photoshop's image-editing software is available for download in a free trial. Fortunately for our sanity, Adobe Premiere Pro has an automatic color match tool built in. And in this article, we'll explain how to use this tool to measure the color of video footage. What you need to get started before you can start working with the Color Match Premiere Pro tool, you need to make sure you are able to use it. First, you'll need the Premiere Pro CC Release April 2018 12.1. This update added a color match tool, so you won't be able to use it on older versions such as CS6. You'll also need a powerful computer to start correcting the color and with Premiere Pro. Adobe Premiere is not always very effective, and color correction is very demanding to the system. You may want to consider creating a 4K computer editing budget. You can also create optimized proxies or follow these Premiere Pro performance tips. If you have The Premiere Pro version and a powerful enough computer, import your frames, and get the original edit ready to go. Prepare a color match tool that works by studying a reference image or video and applying changes to the original frames. In order to use it, you will need to import a reference image or video, and put it on the timeline. You can remove it as soon as your color matching is complete. You can use your own videos or images for reference. One way to get started quickly is with color classification using images from a Hollywood movie. If you find a scene you would like to repeat, then take a screenshot and import it. Using the Color Match tool Once you're ready to go, using the color tool to match is a simple process. It began with the opening of the Lumetri color panel from the Window menu. In addition, open the Color workspace by taking a head start on the window of the Workspaces of the Color. Here's the footage that I'm starting with: This is a shot of our Ben-TC800 4K review projector. Although it's normal, the colors are a bit boring and it's lacking in contrast. Inside the Lumetri color panel, scroll down to and expand the Color Wheels and Match. Select The View Comparison button. This will change the program's monitor to a split screen. The right half shows the current position of the clip and the timeline. The left half shows your reference image. Underneath this is a mini-chronology. Here you can scrub left or right to find your background material in the Timeline. Spread this mini-chronicle in your reference material. Since this clip is from Big Buck Bunny, a screenshot of the source material is a good choice for the link. As you can see, the original is a much better image. The colors are better, the image is brighter, and there's more contrast. Once you've lined up the source material, click Apply Match. The premiere may take a few seconds to show any changes (depending on your computer), but eventually update. Provided you're happy with the match, select Comparison View again to get out of the comparison submission. Here's the result. While it doesn't look exactly like a link, it's much better than it was: Color Match Tool: Extra Options Once you're comfortable with color-appropriate shots, there are some additional options. There are five buttons at the bottom of the program monitor (with a view of comparison). Left to right: Comparison of shots or frames. This will switch the left image between the reference material, and before the preview— what your frames looked like before matching the color. After clicking: The side-by-side button shows the source and links opinions next to each other. This is the default view: The Vertical Split button will change from side to side to view, to a combined view, while being referenced, and the original frames are combined to make one image. You can click and drag on the vertical line to see more or less source or reference material. Here's what it looks like The horizontal split is similar to a vertical split, only this time kind of divided horizontally: Here's how it looks: Finally, the Swap Sides button just changes the original and reference presentations: Here's how it looks: All these buttons exist to make things easier for you as a director. By accurately lining up your before and after shots, and closely comparing your source and reference material, you can be sure that your new image looks like you imagine it in the source material. Adobe Premiere Color Matching in 5 simple steps color match tool is not perfect. This is not always the right thing to do, and it is not a substitute for true color classification and correction. Simple changes in exposure, contrast and white balance can make a big difference. However, the color matching tool is a great way to start color classification frames, especially if you've never color graded before. So here are the steps required to use Adobe Premiere Pro Color Match Tool: Choose the source material: Everything will do for the source material, even shots from big budget productions. Enter the Color Wheels and Match area: It's inside the Lumetri color panel. Select Comparison View: This shows the differences between the link and the source material. Scroll through the source material: Use playhead under the guise of a link. Apply match: The premiere will adjust the colors to match with a single click.
